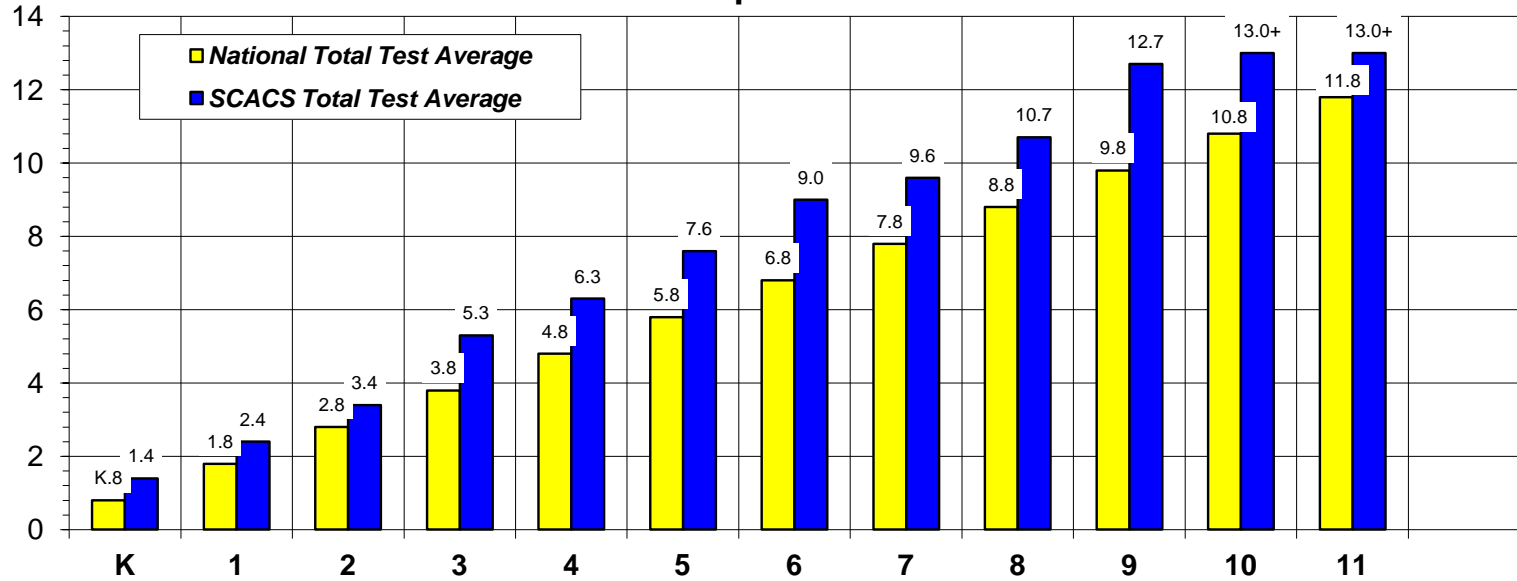


South Carolina Association of Christian Schools' Students Score Higher Than The National Average!

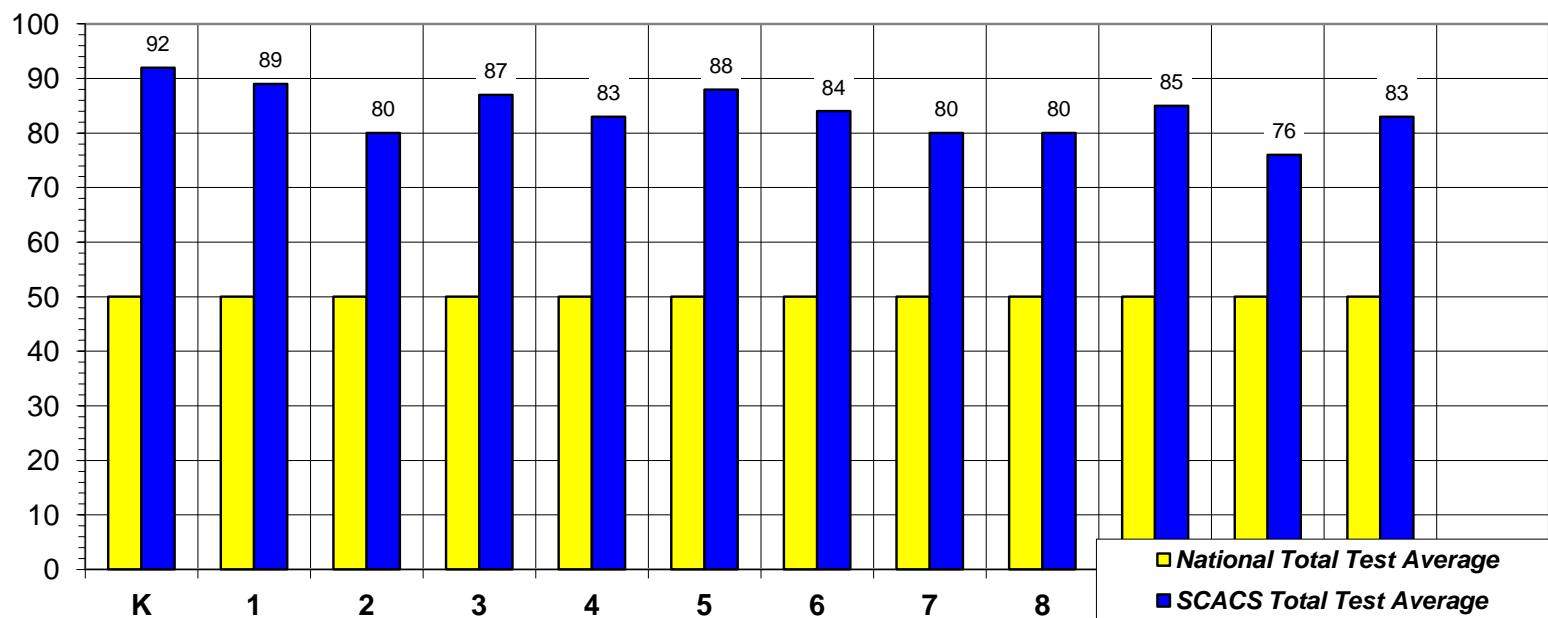
